WHEREAS, Bienvenido Holganza served the people of Alaska as Commissioner of the Alaska State Commission for Human Rights since April 8, 1983;


WHEREAS, the responsibilities and duties of a Human Rights Commissioner were eagerly accepted by Commissioner Holganza;
