RESOLUTION NO. 88-01

WHEREAS, Roberto Garza served as Commissioner of the Alaska State Commission for Human Rights for five years;

WHEREAS, Commissioners are charged with substantial responsibility to eliminate and prevent discrimination in the state of Alaska by adjudicating cases of discrimination, setting policy and interpreting Alaska Human Rights Law, and for directing the activities of the chief civil rights enforcement agency in the state;


WHEREAS, Roberto Garza faithfully carried out his duties as commissioner in a manner which benefitted not only the people of Ketchikan but all Alaskans;

WHEREAS, Roberto Garza continued throughout his lifetime to fight for human rights in every area of human endeavor;

WHEREAS, the memory of Roberto Garza's fervor and tenacious pursuit of justice and equality will endure as an example to the commissioners and staff of the commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Commission for Human Rights extends its heartfelt sympathy to the family of Roberto Garza on the loss of their dear husband, father, and grandfather and to the people of Ketchikan on the loss of their dedicated community leader.
